









- 4. To inform tailored capacity development in meeting the common challenges as identified in the research




In a way to accompany LG reforms in North Africa and allow NELGA North Africa:

Methodology Scope

- Interdisciplinary + Evidence based
- Urban and rural, local/national, govt/private
- Raised the issue of access to civil society, vulnerable groups, equity, HR, youth
- Defragmentation of LG issues to reduce complexity
- Highlight the issue of equity, HR, youth and gender disaggregated data

Research Questions

- Who are the land stakeholders of each NELGA partner?
- What are the strengths or capacity gaps?
- What is the results of SWOT analysis
- Are there any specific needs and challenges related to gender, HR, youth issues
 ? Are there any gender disaggregated data?





Moving forward – Implementing the Capacity Development Strategy and Matrix by Creating linkages between Science and Policy cycle

- How to use the findings?
- What capacities exist, what capacities can we learn from each other and what capacities are further needed in our Network?
