NELGA NORTH AFRICA HUB

DEFICITS ARE PERSISTING AT THE COUNTRY LEVELS

- the individual level: competence, knowledge, communication, information deficits;
- the organizational level: knowledge, cooperation and transfer deficits which do not help create an enabling environment for an integrated capacity development system; and
- societal levels: reliability deficit that make the cooperation arrangements and the network remain unstable and need to develop sustainable strategy to survive longer and achieve better results at the strategic level.

NEEDED TRAINING ACTIONS:

- Developing adequate short programs to respond to the needs of urban planning and land project development,
- Providing professionals with continuous training modern tools of land registration, urban planning, mapping, and cadastral institutions,
- Promoting standardization of the processes and procedures related to land management and land administration,
- Setting up specialized post-graduate curricula in land governance in the form of master's degree, professional master's program, and executive masters.

- The role of academia in coordinating actions between Private and Public partners
- Encourage the integration of new educational paradigms in training and research / Smart tools on land governance
- Promote youth/women initiatives for research actions on land governance: land right access
- Reinforce mastering strategies for good spatial and urban development
- Sharing efforts in training and research in LG
